Dear Bishops, Youth Directors, Coordinators and Youth Office Bearers,

1. National Youth Convention Mangalore, Karnataka

The National Youth Convention was held at St Joseph's Engineering College, Mangalore, Karnataka, South India from January 18 – 22, 2017. On the 18<sup>th</sup> of January, the NYC Cross was received by the ICYM Diocesan Team and was handed over to Regional and National Council team. National Flag, Papal Flag and ICYM flag were hoisted, which was followed by the National Youth Convention Inaugural. Holy Eucharist presided over by Archbishop Most Rev Bernard Moras. The inauguration of the NYC was held after the inaugural mass. Most Rev. Bernard Moras presided over the function. In his presidential address urged the youth to wake up, to be creative, and to serve for a purpose. He also gave a call to the youth to part take in the spiritual activities as they take part in the secular activities.

Mrs. Grace Pinto, Managing Director Ryan International Group of Institutions in her keynote address advised the youth not to say parents are boring, instead be a blessing to them. "Start dreaming, think big, achieve big, think positive. We need vision, passion and compassion which will lead us to uplift the downtrodden". There were 2500 youth from all over India took part in National Youth convention.

In his homily, he gave a message on vocation and about the decision that one has to make. Mar Raphael Thattil Auxiliary Bishop of Trissur, Mar Joseph Arumachadath- Bishop of Bhadravathy, Mar Lawrence Mukkuzhi-Bishop of Bethangady, Most Rev.Henry Dsouza and others concelebrated.

Mr. John Rhee from Germany while addressing the delegates of NYC 2017 shared his experience of Catechesis all around the world and also about evangelization. Presentation on DOCAT was given by Jan-Philipp Goertz, the director for International and Government Affairs for Lufthansa Germany Airlines. Mr Anto Akara, shared his experience of working for the Kandhamal victims.

His Eminence Mar George Cardinal Alencherry - Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Church celebrated the Holy Mass. In his homily, he gave a message on vocation and about the decision that one has to make. Quoting the words of St Teresa- he said, in midst of suffering, Jesus is always with us so never be discouraged. Giving a call to the youngsters he asked to console all those who are suffering because of various reasons. He encouraged the youth saying we are unique in the eyes of our Lord and nobody can replace us. We are wanted by the Lord to proclaim his word and continue his ministry.

Justice Kurian Joseph hon'ble Judge, Supreme Court of India Chief Guest of the Concluding ceremony of X National youth convention in his valedictory note he enlightened the youths on the constitutional rights that we as citizens of India must be united to do good. In Presidential address Archbishop Bernard Moras gave a call to the youths to be united and fight for Justice by upholding Christian Values. Mr Oscar Fernandes Member of Rajya Sabha welcomed the delegates to Mangaluru which is popularly known as Rome of the east. Serving God and Serving the nation goes in hand in hand he said. Youths should make use of all the opportunities they get in their life to serve the humanity" he said.

During the concluding Holy Eucharist H. E. Oswald Cardinal Gracious in his homily called upon the youths to follow Jesus. "Each one of us can have personal relationship with Jesus. Each one of us can meet Jesus. Following the teachings of Christ will help us to walk his way. Transform the society and bring a change by following Jesus' he Said.
