

Report of ICYM Central Council Activities
in the Diocese of Mangalore
July 2015- July 2016

Training programme :

A training programme for the newly elected Executive and Council members was held on July 19th, 2015 from 4.00 PM to July 20th, 2015 3.00 PM at Olivet House Jeppu. Mr. Norbert Misquith was the resource person for the first session who made known to the youth their responsibilities at ICYM and gave more knowledge about the existence of ICYM and idea about conducting various activities and games.

On the second day Fr. Vijay Victor Lobo was the resource person who gave the qualities of being a true and good leader. Group discussions were also conducted. 33 newly elected leaders participated in the Programme.

Financial help to Navyashree and a tribute to Abdul Kalam:

To pay tribute to the role model of the youth Dr. Abdul Kalam, Executive committee decided to have a special programme to pay our respect to this great man. As a tribute to Dr. Kalam, a cancer patient- Navyashree of 8years old was helped financially. Youth of ICYM collected amount from various corners of Mangalore diocese on July 28th,2015 and the collected amount of Rs.1,60,000 was Handed over to their family at 6.00 PM at Circuit house where the tribute programme for Dr. Abdul Kalam was held. MLA Mr. J.R Lobo and other leaders were present for the tribute programme.

Yuva Vinchon:

‘Yuva Vinchon’ (Training of Trainers), was conducted in four different levels to prepare youth to be public speakers and to become resource persons to conduct the training programmes. The first level was conducted on August 28th, 2016 at Jeppu, Olivet house. 27 interested youth took part in this programme.
