Greetings from the KRCBC Youth Commission, Bangalore!

#### 1. The 27<sup>th</sup> KRYC Council:

On March 17, 2024, at 9:00 a.m., the 28th KRYC Council met in



Subodhana (KROSS) in Bangalore. The 66-member council was led our by distinguished chairman, Bishop Most Rev. Henry Dsouza, and included representatives from 14 dioceses well as as members of the

ICYM movements, YCS/YSM, Logos Youth, Jesus Youth, and AICUF. Youth directors and animators committed to furthering our group's goal were among them. Reports from various youth movements and the last KRYC council were delivered during the council meeting.

The active participation of youths from all dioceses and movements enriched the discussions, which encompassed various agendas, forthcoming programs, and deliberations on the Ruby Jubilee year. Consensus was reached on several decisions, reflecting the collective interests of the majority. As the council drew to a close, Ashley Dsouza, Regional ICYM Secretary, expressed heartfelt gratitude to all attendees. The day concluded with a reverent Eucharistic Celebration.

#### 2. The KRYC Election:

During the World Council, elections were held for the post of Secretary General, which was vacated by Mr. Innocent from Kenya after serving the movement for the last four years. Mr. Roshan Lobo from Karnataka region, India was elected as the new Secretary General of the IYCS, and it was a very proud moment for India. Mr. Roshan is the former national leader of YCS/YSM India.


## 9. Nyeleni Global Forum:
