Dear Archbishop/Bishops, Directors, Coordinators, and Youth Leaders,

Greetings from the KRCBC Youth Commission, Bangalore!

1. DELTA Program:

The ICYM Karnataka Region, in collaboration with the diocese of Udupi, organized the first zonal program, "Diocesan Executive



Leaders Training Advancement"-(DELTA) from 17-18 August, 2024 at Anugraha, the diocesan Pastoral Centre, Udupi. The region invited five dioceses, namely Mangalore, Udupi, Belthangady, Puttur and Karwar which come under the coastal zone. The two-day programme was inaugurated by the Most Rev. Gerald Isaac Lobo, the bishop of Udupi. Fr. Lourd Raj, the regional youth director

of ICYM Karnataka, Sr Molly the regional youth lady animator, Fr. Steven Fernandes, Diocesan Youth Director (DYD) of ICYM Udupi Diocese, Mr. Sanjay Dsouza, President of ICYM Karnataka, and Ms. Ashley Dsouza, General Secretary of ICYM Karnataka. The renowned resource persons were invited to engage in a two-day program. There were 55 participants from five dioceses.

2. Director's Meet:

The 11th National Youth Directors and National Youth Movement



Coordinators Meeting was held the at Social Development Centre, Ranchi, from 21 - 24August 2024. A of 132 total youth directors, youth

animators, and young leaders participated in this meeting organized

by the National Youth Commission. Ten directors from the Karnataka region participated in the National Youth Directors Meet. The regional directors and movement coordinators were given time to present their report, provide clarification and even share some good practices of each region, which enlightened other directors to learn and to practice in their own dioceses.

3. The new pastoral plan for Karnataka:

A new pastoral plan for the Karnataka region has been announced with pleasure by the Karnataka Regional Catholic Bishops' Council (KRCBC). The process began three months ago. All the secretaries of different commissions worked together with their own core team to prepare plans for their respective commissions. The final copy was presented to the Karnataka Regional Catholic Bishops' Council, and the same was approved in the council. We remain grateful to Fr. Joe Xavier SJ, who guided and corrected the draft on every level in the long process preparation.

4. MIJARC:

The MIJARC Asia organized training of trainees on child protection



on 6-9 September, 2024 at the Centre for Development Initiatives in Guwahati. Thirtyfive people from the six regions took part in the national training programme. As a resource for the

training programme, Sr. Anna Mary Thumma gave a talk on risk factors, protective and preventive measures, and the impact of child sexual abuse on victims.

5. Jubilee 2025:

As we are aware, the entire church in the world is preparing for the





Jubilee 2025. In the recent directors meeting in Ranchi, it was advised by the national office to all the regions to organize pilgrimage tours to Rome

on the occasion of Jubilee 2025. The youth are given a special invitation to participate in the jubilee from 28^{th} July to 3^{rd} August

2025. The registration begins in November 2024 and ends in January 2025. The registration fee is Rs. 23,000/- Those who wish to participate in the Jubilee, should contact the regional office.

Pope Francis officially unveiled the theme of World Youth Day 2027

and the official logo on Tuesday, 24^{th} September, 2024. The theme of next WYD 2027 is "Take courage. I have overcome the world" (Jh 16:33). Pope Francis said in the press conference that the topic "it is in Jesus 'farewell tale' that prepares his disciples to experience the mystery of Jesus' suffering death in and the assurance of his resurrection," focusing on the testimony and

courage of Jesus' resurrection victory.
